Number 1 plastics are made from polyethylene terephthalate (PET). PET is typically a clear plastic and is often used to make soft drink and water bottles. Number 2 plastics are made from high-density polyethylene (HDPE). HDPE is often used to make milk bottles and detergent bottles.







Needle and Fhread


01. Cut shapes out of the collected plastics



02. Hammer a hole in the middle of the shape



03. Hold plastic shape over the flame until plastic shrinks and curls slightly



04. Sew sequins on fabric and admire your work!
